Dear Governor Raimondo:

Please allow this to serve as a request for additional documents pertaining to the proposed 20-year contract extension between the State Lottery Division of the State of Rhode Island Department of Revenue ("the Lottery") and IGT Global Solutions Corporation ("IGT"). As you are aware, the Rhode Island Senate Committee on Finance initiated its hearings related to the proposed contract extension and Senate Bill 2019-1031 on Thursday, September 19, 2019. The next hearing is scheduled to take place on Tuesday, October 1, 2019.

On behalf of the Senate Committee on Finance, I would appreciate it if you would forward the following to my attention by Monday, September 30, 2019 to assist us as we continue our review.

1. Any and all documents, communications, writings, or media of any kind relating to the initiation of the communications and the subsequent negotiations between or among any and all parties, individuals, and government or private entities, as well as any and all documents, communications, writings, or media of any kind relating to the formation of the contract terms, including emails, attachments or exhibits to those communications. Please include all documents, communications, writings, or media of any kind relating to all communications and consultancy engaged in prior to, during, or for the purpose of the aforementioned negotiations, as well as all forms of proposals and terms.

2. Any and all documents, communications, writings, or media of any kind relating to any amendments to the Master Contract, any waivers, or any agreements as to waivers, as to any of the terms in the Master Contract, in its original form or as subsequently amended, including but not limited to: the terms of those waivers, amendments, or modifications as well as any legal, financial, or impact analyses performed related to those waivers, amendments, or modifications.
3. Any and all documents, communications, writings, or media of any kind relating to the Rhode Island Lottery Commission, the Division of Lottery, or any other state office, agency, or department's monitoring, identifying, and evaluating any history of contract noncompliance since May 2003 and any and all documents, communications, writings, or media of any kind relating to the Rhode Island Lottery Commission, the Division of Lottery, or any other state office, agency, or department's evaluating and determining the appropriate remedy or sanction for such noncompliance.

Thank you for your prompt attention to these requests. I look forward to hearing from you by Monday, September 30, 2019 so that we may continue with this important process.
